



Student Code of Conduct Summer 2005

SAY Sí is committed to provide its students with the highest quality multi-disciplinary arts education. In order to do this, SAY Sí students must observe program policies.

A quality-learning environment requires the following of our students:

- Students are not allowed to leave campus for any reason without staff permission. Staff permission must first be granted before walking to nearby stores and restaurants.
- Drugs, weapons, and abusive language [including music] are not permitted at SAY Sí.
- All Students must complete project assignments in a timely manner.
- Each student must sign in/out for each program on the attendance sheet.
- Student meeting on Monday are mandatory.
- Work areas must be cleaned daily before leaving.
- No visitors are allowed in the SAY Sí classrooms at any time.
- Students are required to participate in and attend every exhibition.
- SAY Sí students must have reliable transportation to and from SAY Sí.
- Students must attend eight to ten hours of studio sessions a week.
- All Students must be a positive and productive influence in the studio.
- Students must model good behavior, respect themselves, others, and the program's and other student's materials and supplies.

Other Requirements

Academics: Students are expected to maintain a C average in their classes. Students who fail to maintain a C average in their academic studies and who fail to meet with staff will be suspended from the program until the next grade period. All students must submit their academic report cards every nine weeks for review. Failure to do so is grounds for suspension from SAY Sí.

Equipment: The use of the SAY SI printers, copier, art materials and equipment [shop and media] should be limited to projects that fall within the context of the program. Use of the SAY SI printers, copier, art materials and equipment for personal use is prohibited unless pre-authorized from the director.

Annual Review: Students are required to have an annual review at the beginning of each calendar year [Jan.]. The annual review will be based on attendance, performance and attitude and will be used to gauge the student's continuation in the program.

Disciplinary Action

Disregard of the above rules calls for disciplinary action. First, the student is warned. Second, a meeting is called with the student and parent. Third, if the problem persists, the student will be dismissed from SAY Sí.

Rules are made for the protection and well being of the student body, and to promote the ideals of scholarship, character, and professional behavior. SAY Sí pledges to provide the highest caliber of training possible in the arts. In return, SAY Sí expects its policies to be honored. SAY Sí wants to train the best artists possible, therefore, the signatures of the student and program staff are required on this form, signifying understanding and agreement with the above rules.
